With reference to your letter of the 2nd instant, the preliminary freeboard for the above vessel is  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " greater than we anticipated from our data of previous vessels.

We enclose therefore amended freeboard particulars giving more details of the tonnages and sheers.

The modified tonnages will give a smaller tonnage coefficient.

Our estimate of the freeboard was based on the S.S. "OLIVA" built by us in 1916 to the following dimensions:- 412'-0" B.P. x 53'-1" B. Mld. x 31'-0 $\frac{1}{2}$ " D. Mld. This vessel had a freeboard of 6'-9" and our No. 1234 is slightly finer than the "Oliva".

We shall be glad if you will let us have a revised freeboard to the modified particulars.
