F. I have to acquaint you that the Freeboard Certificate in respect of the motorship "HELIX" will expire on the 30th instant, and in reply to enquiry regarding the renewal of the Certificate, the Societe Anonyme des Petroles Jupiter of Paris write as follows:-

"We beg to inform you that as this vessel is due to call either at Petit-Couronne or Paulillac about the 14th instant, we shall ask wither your Bordeaux Surveyor or your Rouen Surveyor to carry out the Renewal Survey, since it is not certain that the "HELIX" will call at a French port again for two or three months".

I shall therefore be glad if you will give the matter your attention in the event of it being decided to have the Renewal Survey carried out in your district. A copy of the Rpt. C.11 on the case is enclosed for your guidance.

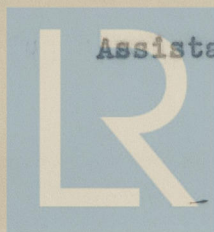
