Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you I am advised by Messrs. The Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co.Ld., of this City, that the Motorship "HELIX" is due to arrive at Marseilles on Monday next the 11th instant when she will be transferred to the French flag. The new Owners will be Soc. Anon. Francaise des Petroles Shell, 46 Boulevard St. Saens, Algiers, and the Port of Registry Algiers.

I shall therefore be glad if you will arrange for the freeboard marking to be amended in accordance with the enclosed memorandum and forward a verification of marking form with a view to the issue of fresh certificates.
