With reference to the verification of marking form and copy of Dutch assignment letter in respect of the motorship "BOSCHFONTEIN" ex "NIEUWKERK" it is observed that an all-seasons freeboard of 1.37m has been marked. A Summer freeboard, however, of 1.18m with the usual seasonal allowances was computed in this Office as shown on the assignment letter forwarded to you on the 27th ultimo, and in the circumstances I shall be glad to learn whether the difference in the freeboards is consequent upon the Dutch Passenger Regulations, and if not, the reason for the same.
