Messrs. P. Smit Jr's No. 418.

I beg to enclose copy of a letter together with a plan received from Messrs. P. Smit Jr., relative to the above vessel now building for classification with the Society.

The point on which they desire an opinion is whether the tonnage opening on the deck "E" may have abreast it side houses as shown and be overhung by the poop deck above, and at the same time be effective for its purpose of allowing the upper tween deck spaces to be exempted from tonnage measurement.

While it is realised that the matter of their inquiry is not exactly the province of the Society, an expression of opinion would be of advantage to the Builders not necessarily to be quoted as such but to assist them to appreciate what would be the bearing of the British Tonnage Regulations did the vessel come under these regulations. As however this is not the case the opinion of the Society is sought and it is thought that the Builders might be met in this matter.
