I have checked the thickness of plating on Bulkheads  
No 56 & 70, also spacing of stiffeners on after Part  
Bulkhead. Spacing of Longitudinals at the ends;  
and certify that they all conform to approved sizes;  
Speed of vessel is not expected to exceed 10 knots  
loaded. Draft: as in the case of sister vessels.
