Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th instant respecting Glasgow Report No. 40971 on the Steamer "CAMERONIA", and, in reply to your various enquiries, to state:-

- (1) "Q" strake of shell plating is doubled at the after break.
- (2) The thickness and riveting of this strake at the forward break is as approved.
- (3) The diameter of the main piece of the rudder at the coupling, the construction of the bulkheads throughout, and the pumping arrangements are as approved.
- (4) The Downton pump has been dispensed with as per approved plan.
- (5) Particulars of the lengths and capacity of the tanks at the sides of the tunnels are as per enclosed plan.
- (6) The screw shafts are fitted with continuous liners the whole length of the stern tube.
