Dear Warlow,

You may remember that the Twin Screw Steamer "CAMERONIA" left Glasgow I think in March last without the Electric Lighting Installation being completed, and we received a report from the Society's Surveyors at Havre in May stating that the work had been carried out, and asking us to collect the expenses amounting to £3:16:9. I believe the work was done at Sherbourg and consequently these expenses were incurred by the Havre Surveyors in visiting that place.

The account was rendered to the Owners on the 11th May, a copy of which I enclose, but up to the present has not been settled, and the Havre Surveyors are enquiring whether the matter has been over-looked.

Would it be possible for you to let somebody call at the Office with the account reminding them of the matter, with a view to obtaining an early settlement.
