Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that the Convention Ordinary Freeboards have been computed in the case of the sailing vessel "ABRAHAM RYDBERG" on the basis of the information supplied in Gothenburg Report C/11 No.8895, and the Report and computation are enclosed herewith, together with the freeboard certificate, in triplicate.

As the Convention freeboards are greater than those computed on the basis of the 1906 regulations, the freeboards have been assigned on this latter basis. I have to point out, however, that the freeboards now assigned differ slightly from the existing freeboards, on account of the sheathing on the freeboard deck being now three inches thick, instead of four inches thick as previously reported.
