on the 4th April, and subsequently, 195 6 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~found~~:—

An additional access hatch to No.1 Hold has been fitted by Owners, starboard side of freeboard deck abreast main mast.

Access is by means of an opening in deck plating between adjacent beams, approx. 30" x 20" with well rounded corners.

An efficient fabricated $\frac{3}{8}$ " steel coaming 38" in height with E.W. attachment to deck. Coaming is also extended below deck and E.W. as compensation.

The hatch is closed by an efficient hinged steel W.T. cover secured by turnbuckles.
