With reference to the case of your new steamer "MONKSTONE", I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Bristol from which it appears that in order to complete the classification survey of the machinery the engines require to be tried under steam, the safety valves of the boilers to be adjusted under steam, the pumps to be tried and the bilge arrangements and spare gear to be examined.

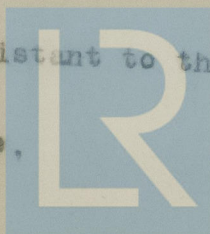
