



This vessel was classed on the 26th ultimo 100A1 "With freeboard", "For service in the Straits of Malacca, including Pontianak".

It would now appear that on the 16th August 1923 a proposal of the Owners to have the class amended ^{to} 100A1 "With freeboard" was approved provided the hatchway coamings on the upper deck be made 24" high.

The hatchway coamings have been fitted 24" high as required and it is submitted the class of the vessel be amended to 100A1 "With freeboard".
