I beg to acknowledge the receipt of the Classing letter of the 26th instant, regarding the First Entry Report No. 8493, on the steamer "KHOEN HOEN", and have to inform you the side keelsons are fitted with foundation plates as approved, 10" x 40/36, and .50 in the Boiler space. The shade deck stringer angle is $3\frac{1}{2}$ x $3\frac{1}{2}$ x .43, and not as stated in the Report.

With regard to the Class of the vessel, I beg to state that the recommendation was made in view of your letter dated M. 7th August 1924, and the correspondence with Glasgow, quoted in my letter of the 4th August 1924.
