### SOURCE OF INFORMATION

MICAELA. — London, Feb. 15. — Motor vessel Micaela, owners Compania Anonima Maritima Delta: The following cables have been received from New York:

Dated Feb. 8: Venezuelan Naval Attache, Bogota, reports Micaela lost en route from Puerto Cortez to La Guaira, loaded timber. Seven members of crew reached Colombian coast in vicinity of Puerto Colombia. Search instituted for other lifeboat with seven men.

Dated Feb. 14: Micaela: Owners tender abandonment of vessel to underwriters as total loss as crew abandoned vessel when sinking and Colombian Navy search of three days was unfruitful; considered remote vessel adrift. Venezuelan Naval Station issued warnings and instructions to report wreck, none received. All crew saved.

MICAELA.—London, Feb. 20.—The following message has been received from New York, dated Feb. 17: Motor vessel Micaela: Presume Lloyd's Agents advised Salvage Association sinking due to heavy weather. (See issue of Feb. 16.)


