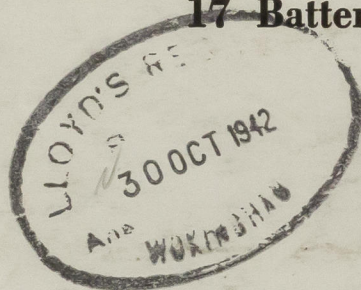

Dear Sir:

I duly received your letter of 15th July last regarding the motorship "ST. EUSTATIUS", the contents of which have been noted.

With regard to the machinery, according to the information received here each main engine developed 160 BHP at 225 RPM. With 2 SCSA heavy oil engines having 2 cylinders 16-1/2" dia. by 18-7/8" stroke and 83% mechanical efficiency, this would correspond to a mean indicated pressure of 42 lbs. per square inch.

The matter has been referred to the Society's Surveyor at Curacao, and I attach a statement which Mr. Chapman has furnished regarding the machinery.
