The above named vessel has recently been under the survey of the Curacao Surveyor with a view to classification with, and assignment of freeboards by, the Society.

The vessel will be used for the carriage of sulphuric acid in portable cylindrical tanks between Curacao and Aruba.

One set of plans have been forwarded to this office and the scantlings have been found generally suitable for minimum freeboards in the proposed service.

I am enclosing herewith the Surveyor's Reports C11 and C11(comp.), together with a copy of the Provisional Certificate which has been issued on the basis of the vessel's old freeboard certificate. I shall be glad to have particulars of the final freeboards at your convenience.

The various reports, etc. in connection with the proposed classification of the vessel will be forwarded at an early date.

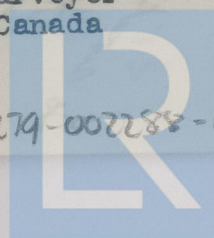
