The stream wire and tow line have been tested as required.

I consider that the notation pt. asp. and pt. cem. should be made in this case,

The tanks were cemented and Walker-Dove Bitumastic hot enamel solution was applied to the Machinery space floors and coal bunkers.

No hand pumps were fitted to hold,
only semi-rotary pump to fore peak tank flat.
