Dear Sir,

M. I duly received your letter of the 31st ultimo enclosing your First Entry Report No. 3294 on the Steamer "WHEATCROP", and with regard thereto I shall be glad if you will be good enough to state whether the Owners' consent has been obtained to the vessel being built in accordance with the Revised Rules.

It is concluded that the height of the tank side brackets above the margin plate, the thickness of the forecastle stringer angle, the size of the raised quarter deck stringer plate, angle and deck plating are as approved, and that the riveting of the seams and butts and the thickness of the butt straps and breaking stress of the steel wires are in accordance with the Revised Rules, but I shall be glad if you will be good enough to state if this is so.
