Dear Sir,

s. s. "ROTHER" - REFRIGERATION

Further to my letter of the 8th instant regarding our steamers "Don" and "Dearne"; the s. s. "Rother" is also to be now requisitioned by the Ministry of War Transport for carrying refrigerated cargoes, and arrangements are being made for similar extensions to the installation in this vessel as those for the other two vessels.

The "Rother" does not at present hold your R. M. Certificate.

The extensions to the plant will be undertaken by Messrs. J. & E. Hall, and additions to the insulation by the Cork Insulation & Asbestos Co., and the work will be carried out in due course at Holyhead.

Will you please arrange for such inspections of this work as will enable you to issue your R. M. C. on completion.

Captain MacKenzie, Holyhead, will give your Surveyor any further details of the work which he may require.


