## SOURCE OF INFORMATION

RUPERT BRAND. — St. John's, NF.,  
June 29.—Sub-agent at Corner Brook  
telegraphed to-day: Department of  
Transport here advised last night that  
steamer AVENIR collided with fish  
laden vessel Rupert Brand in Port au  
Choix area yesterday. Crew were re-  
moved from Rupert Brand and vessel  
later sank. Crew now on way here on  
tug Louise Simard and AVENIR.  
St. John's, NF.,  
June 29.—The Montreal tug Louise  
Simard arrived at Corner Brook to-day  
with five of the crew of 13 of the motor  
trawler Rupert Brand, which was in col-  
lision yesterday with the Norwegian  
steamer AVENIR off the coast of New-  
foundland. The men, who were not  
injured, were taken off just before the  
trawler sank. They said that the  
AVENIR picked up the remaining eight  
of the crew. She is due at Corner Brook  
later to-day.—Reuter.

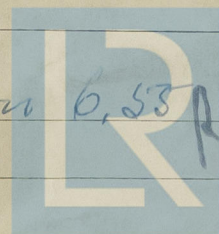
