
Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines

There are two pipe scuppers $2\frac{1}{2}$ " diam., led from the raised quarter deck aft, 1 port and 1 starboard, thro' shell plating and fitted with non-return valves at shell about 2'0" below the raised quarter deck, and situated at aft end of engine room.
