
Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 27th February respecting the case of the steamer "BENGKALIS", No. 70728 in the Register Book, we beg to acquaint you that a General Examination of this vessel has been partly held at this port and the vessel has now proceeded to Glasgow, where the remainder of the cargo is to be discharged and the General Examination completed.

With regard to the penultimate paragraph of our letter to Glasgow, we beg to state that the Owners' proposal for the necessary repairs to the fore peak bulkhead riveting and boiler room wing oil fuel tanks being deferred merits, in our opinion, the favourable consideration of the Committee, provided, in the case of the fore peak tank, no water is carried in this tank.

Our report on the case will be forwarded in due course.
