Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 10th inst. regarding my 1st Entry Report on the S.S. "CLAN MATHESON", Grk. Rpt. No. 17446, and in reply thereto I find it is not quite clear on the copy of the Report, whether the spacing of the stiffeners on bulkhead No. 84 was marked "ditto" to that of the spacing on bulkhead No. 72 as this is in accordance with my notes: if this has been omitted, I much regret it.

With reference to the webs on No. 84, these were fitted 36 X .40 with a 3" flange on face, the report simply states webs as approved. The dry tank is eighteen feet in length and was tested to 12 lbs. pressure on the 27th December 1918.

I am sorry this information was not given.
