With reference to your letter of yesterday's date we confirm our communication by 'phone informing you that the above ship, owing to a fire burst on board, was voluntarily stranded near Cape Sidero (Creta Island) on the 24th August, 1958.

Afterwards, she was refloated by the Salvage Company Nicolas E. Vernicos, of the Piraeus, and towed to Piraeus where she is at present lying with her cargo of cement, part of which was heaved overboard in order to facilitate her ~~the~~ refloating.

The ship was declared a "Constructive Total Loss" and the wreckage will be sold for breaking up purposes as soon as it has been freed from her present cargo.

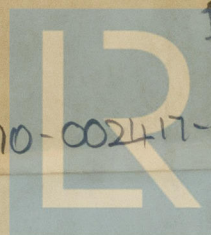
