Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo enclosing an endorsement by Dr. Montgomerie regarding the arrangement of bulkheads in Messrs. Barclay, Curle & Co's No. 600, I am directed to inform you that the case received the consideration of the General Committee at their Meeting today, when it was decided that the special survey during construction may be proceeded with, but that before the vessel is finally classed in the Register Book it will be necessary for a letter to be furnished by the Owners desiring the omission of the intermediate 'tween deck bulkheads in the forward and after holds, and assigning a reason for the omission in the terms of the Committee's Circular No. 1238.

If this be done, a notation will be made in the Register Book in respect of the bulkheads as recommended by Dr. Montgomerie, but shortened to read as follows:-

"Intermediate 'tween deck bulkheads in forward
"and after holds dispensed with; 4 BH to upper deck;
"2 BH to second deck".
