All the requirements of the Approved Plans and Ministry of Shipping Specification have been carried out.

Official trials were carried out in the Firth of Clyde on the 22nd April, 1941.

Anchor and Steering Gear Trials were satisfactory, and the main and auxiliary machinery operated efficiently throughout.


