The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/62.)

The history of this case is fully stated on Endorsement dated 7.7.58 and memo dated 18.9.58.

The Notation "Survey Overdue 11,57" appears in the Register Book.

The class is subject to bottom shell plating and port side longitudinal bulkhead in No.1 centre tank being dealt with as necessary and to holed side shell plating 4th & 5th strakes below sheer (s.s.a) being permanently repaired before ship resumes service, also to bow plating being further examined and to indented side shell plating etc. (p.s.f) in way of fore hold being repaired at the next drydocking.

The HAMBURG Surveyors now report (5,60), ship examined afloat and in dry dock and a General Examination carried out to enable ship to proceed as an unclassified ship to Piraeus.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED
