With reference to my letter dated the 16th November last addressed to the Owners, a copy of which was forwarded to you, and your Report No.13655, I shall be glad to learn whether the ship is still being used to ferry cargo from laid up vessels in the River Fal to Falmouth within the harbour limits.

Information is also requested regarding the arrangements proposed to be made for the defective tubes in the port donkey boiler to be renewed to entitle the vessel to the notation DBS 12.59.

It will be noted from the Supplement to the Register Book that the vessel was last examined in drydock by the Society's Surveyors in March, 1958.


