BERNY. — Gothenburg, Feb. 17. — Panamanian steamer TYNE collided with Finnish motor vessel Berny (Skutskar for Manchester and Preston) in fog near Laeso N. Light-vessel late on Feb. 16. Berny sank; crew saved by TYNE and brought in here.

Stockholm, Feb. 17. — Gothenburg radio station reported early to-day that motor vessel Berny had sunk three miles off the Danish island of Laeso following a collision last night with steamer TYNE. The crew of the Berny were taken on board the TYNE, which received only minor damage, the report said.—British United Press.
