With reference to your letter of the 2nd instant regarding the above ship, we now beg to inform you that the owners state that the ship will in the near future be towed to U.K. for breaking up.

The owners now desire a certificate for the voyage as unclassified ship, and part survey has been held.

One donkey boiler has also been examined as steam will be required for light and pumping.

The diesel generator engines have been removed for fitting in the "SAMUEL BAKKE" together with other components of the machinery, and the machinery from the "SAMUEL BAKKE" will be carried on deck amidships on the above ship.

We shall be glad to be informed as soon as possible that the survey may be completed and certificate issued, and will inform of the name of the buyers as soon as this is known.
