Steamer "BEAULY"

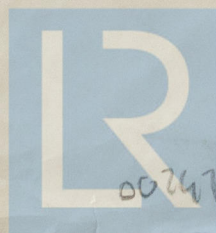
We have been informed by the Glasgow Office that this ship has been sold for breaking up in Belgium and it is understood that she sailed from Glasgow for your port on the 6th May.
