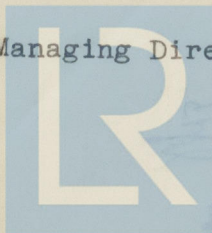
We have, of course, obtained the Ministry of Transport's approval to the transaction, and when the transfer materialises we shall advise you accordingly.
