

"BRITISH MIGHT" - Messrs. Harland & Wolff's Yard No.1196G

Rule Dimensions:- 460' x 59' x 34.83' (level sheer)

This is a tanker of the standard 12,000 tons design submitted by the Director of Merchant Shipbuilding and is, in general, similar to the Blythwood S.B. Co's Yard Nos.80/1, excepting for several internal modifications made to suit the Builders' arrangements.

Plans were dealt with in the Glasgow Office in July 1943, and on subsequent dates, for the class 100A1 "Carrying petroleum in bulk" with the special notation "Longitudinal Framing at Bottom and at Deck".

There is nothing further in the correspondence affecting the First Entry Report which is not covered by the approved plans.
