

# LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

This is to Certify that I have surveyed the S.S. "ARO" 7221 tons gross of Panama whilst afloat at Kynossoura on the 7th June, 1960 and subsequently on account of General Examination for extension of surveys for a voyage to LA SPEZIA, Italy, in ballast condition,

and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will Recommend that she be continued as now classed in the Register Book, without fresh record of survey, subject to all outstanding surveys and side shell plates port side in way of engine room being dealt with on vessel's arrival LA SPEZIA, and by the end of July, 1960.
