Messrs. Alfred Holt & Co., have decided to sell their "ASPHALION" for breaking up purposes, at Hong Kong.

The present arrangements for the ship are that she completes her present voyage to the United Kingdom some time towards the end of May.

Her Load Line Certificate expires on the 1st June, and you will see that the end of the year of grace is the end of June 1959. It may well be that she will be back at Hong Kong before the year of grace expires.

In order that they do not run into any difficulties with the ship, Messrs. Alfred Holt & Co., would like to have an extension of the Load Line Certificate, and ~~for~~ the Committee to agree to allow the vessel to remain in Class for a short time beyond the end of the year of grace.

The outward arrangements for the ship have not yet been fully made, but to cover any contingency which may arise, Messrs. Alfred Holt & Co., would very much appreciate the Committee giving them an extension, say, to the middle of August. They hope, however, that the vessel will be in Hong Kong for breaking up some time before that date.


