The case of the above named ship has been reported to the Committee today in the light of the comments contained in your letter of the 14th instant.

The Committee are of course sympathetic to the Owners' desire to take the ship to Hong Kong without any unnecessary work being undertaken and, in the circumstances, they have agreed to maintenance of class for the voyage in question.

As regards the load line certificate, it is found that the existing certificate was apparently made valid until 1st June 1960, and accordingly only an Annual Survey will be due in June. It is, however, customary to permit a period of grace of up to three months for an Annual Survey and we should therefore not press the Owners to carry out such an inspection before taking the ship to Hong Kong, it being noted she should arrive there before the middle of August.
