MESSRS.HOLT'S LETTER DATED 10th FEB.1951.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Firm be thanked for the information given in the above letter, and they be informed arrangements are being made to send the requisite instructions and information to the Society's Surveyors at Singapore regarding the surveys on the "CHARON," "GORGON," "ASPHALION" "IDOMENEUS" and "ORESTES." That with regard to the "AJAX", action will be deferred pending receipt of promised information.

That the Firm be informed that as there are several particulars regarding the above vessels which require clarification, it will be appreciated if they would be good enough to answer the following queries:

- (1) "IDOMENEUS" & "ORESTES." It is believed the plans in the Society's possession do not show the present arrangement of the refrigerated cargo spaces, particularly with regard to the addition of an aftercastle and the sub-division of No. 4 Upper 'tween Decks for the carriage of chilled beef, a further plan showing the spaces as now fitted is requested.
- (2) "CHARON" and "GORGON." The number, B.H.P. and output of cooler fans, and total length and outside diameter of each air cooler piping.  
Also details of low temperature chambers, if fitted.
- (3) "ASPHALION." Total length and outside diameter of air cooler piping, number, B.H.P. and output of cooler fans. Also total length and outside diameter of piping in each evaporator.
