"Beattie" Oil Gland

With reference to my letter of the 10th ultimo, I have now to confirm that the screwshafts of the vessels "BRIGADIER" and "FORAGER" are fitted with the "Beattie" approved type oil gland, i.e. with metal insert rings.

In the case of the third vessel, the "CAMPAIGNER" no mention is made of the metal insert ring, but there is not the slightest reason to doubt the Owners' records, which have been sighted. It is strongly recommended therefore, that this vessel should also receive the "O.G." notation.

The "WRESTLER" is the only vessel of the fleet fitted with the original type oil gland i.e. without metal insert ring, and an examination of the gland will take place at an early date. It is understood that this gland will be replaced when the screwshaft is completely withdrawn.
