I have your memorandum of the 6th August and note your remarks.

Provided a satisfactory General Examination is carried out between now and October, as proposed, there will be no objection to the Special Survey being deferred, but in view of this ship's age, the period of postponement will be determined by the condition as found at the General Examination.

It is concluded that the Screwshaft Survey, which becomes due at the end of the present month, will also be dealt with at the General Examination. The Boiler Survey will become due at the end of December next.

With regard to the Refrigerated Cargo Installation, it will be in order for the Special RMC Survey to be postponed for a similar period to that which is approved for the Special Survey of the hull and machinery. You will, however, observe that an Intermediate Survey becomes due in December next.
