Dear Sir,

With reference to the copies of the renewal freeboard survey reports which have been received from the New Orleans Surveyor on the Honduras steamers "NICARAO" and "ATLANTIDA", I have to acquaint you that freeboard certificates issued on behalf of the Board of Trade prior to the coming into force of the International Load Line Convention are no longer valid and it is not in order to renew these certificates until March, 1934.

Steps should therefore be taken by the Owners to secure new certificates in accordance with the Convention Regulations, and pending the adoption of these Regulations by the Honduras Authorities, the certificates may be on U.K. or U.S.A. forms.
