With reference to your letter dated the 27th April to the London Office and their reply of the 4th May, the ship has recently been under survey at this port for General Examination.

As a result of the satisfactory nature of this inspection the Scottish Sub-Committee of Classification has approved the postponement of the Special Survey until September, 1961.

The ship was examined in drydock and the main boiler survey held. Fresh records of DS 8,60 and MBS 9,60 have been assigned.

The condition of class in respect of the bower anchor and chain cable was dealt with at this time.

The ship's class has been continued subject to keel plates Nos. 1 and 2 and shell plates A.4 (p. & s.) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey.

Will you kindly inform the Owners accordingly.
