ELETRIC.—London, Aug. 12.—Panamanian steamer Eletric, Mormugao for Lubeck, reported this afternoon: All holds and engine-room full of water, will abandon the ship.

Aden, Aug. 12.—Reported by local agents: Steamer Eletric is aground south of Masirah, near Ras al Jidufa. Tank of bilges full of water at 24 ft.

Bahrein, Aug. 14.—Steamer Eletric: Reports indicate vessel drifted on to beach at Masirah at 9 30 a.m., G.M.T., Aug. 13, with bottom badly damaged and engine-room flooded. Crew of 27 transferred to tank steamer Ras al Ardh, bound Suez.

Muscat, Aug. 14.—Motor tanker British Premier advises steamer Eletric aground between Ras Yei and

Ras al Jidufa on Aug. 12 and all crew taken off by tank steamer Ras al Ardh. Eletric was flooded and went aground about one mile off land.

London, Aug. 14.—The managers of tank steamer Ras al Ardh report that the following radio message has been received from the vessel, timed 9 25 a.m., G.M.T., Aug. 13: Have taken off full crew of 27 men from Panamanian steamer Eletric, stranded in position lat. 20 43 N., long. 58 53 E., one mile NW. of Ras al Jidufa, Masirah Island. All men fit and well. My boats recovered free of damage.

ELETRIC.—London, Sept. 1.—The following message has been received from Muscat, dated Aug. 28: Steamer Eletric, near Masirah: Royal Air Force estimate that at present rate of settling vessel may be a total loss in two weeks or less. She is also heeling to starboard. They have removed to safe custody compass, rockets and signal pistol. There are a number of small items including cigarettes and consumables which could be salvaged now. (See issue of Aug. 15.)

ELETRIC.—Muscat, Sept. 10.—Steamer Eletric: Permission now received, salvage vessel Ocean Salvor effecting salvage.—Lloyd's Sub-agents per Salvage Association. (See issue of Sept. 2.)
