The Owners of the above vessel, in conjunction with our Superintendent Engineer Mr. J.R. Douglas, have requested us to approach you with a view to ascertaining the possibility of extending the time limit for the carrying out of her next Special Survey until May 1962.

The ship carried out at Immingham her last Special Survey of Hull and Machinery in May 1957 and, unfortunately, soon after the Owners, due to lack of employment, had to lay her up at Newport. Mon. in December 1957.

During the time the steamer has been laid up at Newport Mon the personnel on board have taken great care to see that the Hull, Decks and Machinery have been well looked after.

The Owners would like to know if the Committee would state what Survey would be required for them to extend the time required for the next Special Survey of Hull and Machinery until May 1962.

We may mention that the Owners have already given instructions for all other Surveys, now due, to be carried out forthwith.

In the circumstances we shall esteem it a favour if you will be good enough to place the matter before your Committee for their consideration.
