"Leelee" and "Lutona".

In reply to your letter of the 28th January we have been informed by the Surveyor appointed for reconditioning that the "Lutona" is due at South Dock, Millwall, any day.

"Leelee". This vessel has already berthed at South Dock, Millwall, and a preliminary inspection has been carried out by our Representative and Mr. Hudson for the D.S.R.

Arrangements are being made for the vessel to be docked as soon as conditions of labour are arranged. The same procedure will be adopted with the "Lutona".
