Ltd., attend their Works in Bradford on the 4th September, 1946, in order to examine and test one Horizontal Two Stage, Feed Water Heater No. 722, together with Automatic Air Release, Bypass Valves, Drain Bottle, 2½" Pressure Filter No. 732 and 2½" Gravitation Filter No. 733 intended for Messrs. Amos & Smith Ltd., Engine No. 793.

Two Stage Heater.

2½" Pressure Filter.

2½" Gravitation Filter.

The tubes and headers of the feed water heater, the Automatic air release, the by-pass valves and pressure filter were hydraulically tested to 500 Lbs. per square inch, the body of the feed water heater and drain bottle were hydraulically tested to 150 Lbs. per square inch and the gravitation filter to 30 Lbs. per square inch, with satisfactory results.

The materials and workmanship, so far as could be seen, are considered satisfactory.
