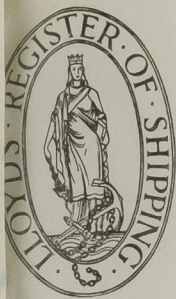

survey, subject to windlass, after peak middle line bulkhead,
hatchway horizontal stiffeners and amidship deep tank structure
being re-examined and dealt with as necessary by the next Special
Survey, but not later than the end of February, 1960.
