Motorship "ECHODALE"

A report has been received from the Society's Falmouth Surveyors of a survey carried out between May and July last, from which it is noted the ship has been examined in drydock, the Donkey Boiler Survey held and the screwshaft renewed.

The Surveyors report the auxiliary condenser water end casting and both end covers were found to be wasted, and recommend that they be renewed before the end of June, 1959. The class of the ship has accordingly been continued subject to this matter receiving attention by that time.

Fresh records of Docking Survey 6,58, Donkey Boiler Survey 7,58, Tailshaft Survey (New) 6,58 have been assigned.
