Dear Sir,

I refer to your letter of the 5th January last regarding the case of the m.v. "PAK-PAK" and other cases at Sorong on which reports are outstanding.

I also note your remarks regarding Mr. Holl and may say that I have since received a letter from Mr. Meermans on the same subject - a copy of which I enclose for your information.

The question of the survey for classification of ships based on Sorong has received consideration. It is not considered to be a proper arrangement that these ships should remain in Class without a confirmatory survey by one of the Society's Exclusive Surveyors. It has therefore been decided that Mr. R. Rodger, the Society's Senior Surveyor at Singapore, should visit Sorong at an early date to investigate the position on the spot and to report to the Committee. He will discuss the classification of these ships with the Owners, and will also call upon Mr. Meermans and interview the two men who are proposed to act on the Society's behalf.

Mr. Rodger has been fully informed of the position so far as is known in this Office, but if you have any information which you consider he should know, please advise him at once. Mr. Meermans is being advised of Mr. Rodger's intended visit.

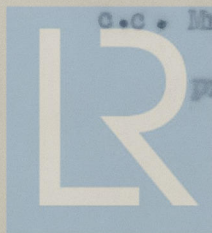
