## This is to Certify that I have

surveyed the S.S. "ANDREAS G" 4913 tons gross of Beirut whilst lying at anchor at Kynosoura & in the Govt. Graving Dock at Piraeus on 22nd December, 1959 & subsequently on account of Docking Survey damage (1) stated caused by heavy weather on voyage from Colombo (India) to Genoa, 31st Dec. 1957 to 25th Jan. 1958 (2) damage due to touching ground at Hesthammaren, Sauda Harbour, on 18th August, 1957,

that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will recommend that she be continued as now classed in the Register Book with fresh record of D.S. 12,59, subject to bent stem bar buckled plates A1 p & s to the cross bunker not being used O.F. until permanently repaired and being dealt with on vessel's arrival at Japan.


