


Nature of Survey COMPLETION-OF SPECIAL SURVEY OF ENGINES AND BOILERS FOR S.S.-No.-

This Survey, due 7.52 ^{now} ~~partly held-at~~ ^{now} ~~completed, and the following repairs carried out (due to~~):-

Docking. Screwshaft drawn and examined. Stermbush rewooded. A few combustion chamber side stays renewed in the centre boiler and surface cracks in way of centre combustion chamber back plate made good by welding. The vessel has now been converted to burn oil fuel in accordance with Rule requirements and approved plans. Some additional electric wiring installed.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed, with notation of ~~IMC~~ 9.52, S 8.52, ^{as recommended.} fitted for oil fuel 9.52, FP above 150°F.
